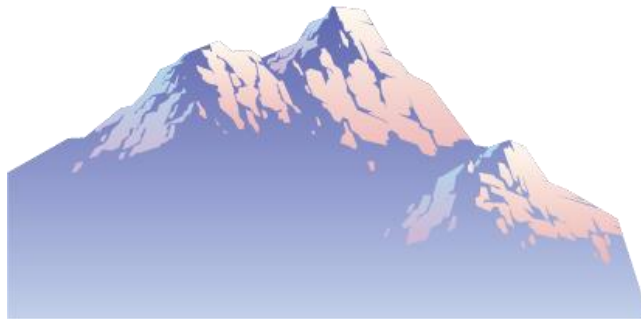

BEFORE CAMP STARTS:

1. **Complete required forms in your YMCA account.** Go to "My Classes" — "Question Forms" section of your account.
2. **Enter authorized pick-ups in your YMCA account.** Go to "More" — "Authorized Pick-ups." Authorized pick-ups are individuals who have permission to drop off and pick up a camper from YMCA Summer Camp. (Note: Even if you are a parent, guardian or family member on the camper's Y membership account, you still need to be added as an authorized pick-up in order check the child in/out of camp.)

CAMP HOURS:

Day Camp: 8 AM – 4 PM | Monday – Friday

Before Camp care: 6:30 AM – 8 AM | Select locations, additional cost

After Camp care: 4 PM – 5:30 PM | All locations, additional cost

Specialty Camps:

Adventure Camp: Monday – Thursday | 8 AM – 4 PM

Basketball & Culinary Camp: Monday – Friday | 8 AM – 4 PM

IMPORTANT DATES:

May 15: Full Camp Payment Due

June 2: First Day of Camp (Varies slightly by location; [confirm on the Summer Camp webpage](#))

May 3: Summer Camp Kickoff

June 19: No Camp (holiday)

July 4: No Camp (holiday)

WHAT TO BRING/WEAR:

- Closed-toe shoes
- Weather/activity-appropriate clothing (YMCA camp T-shirt on field trip days)
- Backpack
- Water bottle
- Lunch and 2 snacks
- Swimsuit and towel (on swim days)

DROP-OFF & PICK-UP:

You will receive specific instructions about drop-off and pick-up in an email from your site supervisor the week prior to your camp start. Be sure to bring a **photo ID** and your **authorized pick-up PIN** to check your camper in/out.



WHAT TO EXPECT AT CAMP:

Campers can expect to learn, make friends and have fun. To meet their diverse interests, each day at Y Camp includes a variety of activities, including:

- **Group Games** filled with laughter and learning to get active, have fun and build bonds among campers.
- **Arts & Crafts** such as drawing, painting and pottery to unleash camper creativity and give space for self-expression and sharing.
- **Field Trips** every week to a variety of area destinations, including museums, gardens, pools, parks and amusement centers.

Throughout all activities, our trained staff support campers with positive interaction, clear behavioral expectations and age-appropriate consequences in order to ensure safety for all, foster a welcoming environment and uphold our Y values.
